# "We Threw the Astrolabe at a Badger..." Judges' Notes from the Medieval Science Fair, Scientific Instruments Section

- We threw the *astrolabe* at a badger, but it was only stunned, and decamped. The second throw (at a hare) produced a better result, killing the target. We stewed and ate the hare. We are awarding 10 points for the hare, but only three for the badger.
- The most nimble of the judges was elected by the others to mount the weather vane on the roof, but as the day was clear and calm it could find no weather to point to. We were therefore unable to judge this entry.
- The shepherd's crook was very finely aligned, and in fact we used it to remove several perturbed jugglers from the performing-arts stage. Nice work!
- Unfortunately the judge testing the compass set out two days ago and has not yet returned, so we are
  unable to award any points. We disavow, as a tasteless brag, one judge's statement that he slipped a
  magnet into a pocket of the tester.
- The *anvil* was ruled authentic, weighty, and useful, but not an instrument. It was therefore disqualified from the competition.
- The *alchemical glassware*, after being deliberately dropped from table-height (onto the anvil), broke into shards, and so was ruled insufficiently sturdy. [We were subsequently forced to invent the *broom*.]



This is held as part of an Open Archery Practice through UCSD Recreation. There is a \$1.00 fee to use the facility. The UCSD Range has been temporarily relocated to the Torrey Pine Gliderport until approximately the end of summer 2011. Parking at the Gliderport site is free. From I-5 exit at Genesee Avenue westbound. At the top of the hill, turn left (south) on to North Torrey Pines Road. Continue two more traffic signals to Torrey Pines Scenic Drive and turn right (west). This is the street just before you reach the Salk Institute. On weekdays, drive about 300 yards and look for an open gate into overflow parking for Salk Institute staff. Turn right (north) and you'll see a fenced area with green netting on it straight ahead. This is the Archery range. On Sundays, the gate to Salk overflow parking is closed. Instead of turning here, continue westbound until you reach the cul-de-sac at the end of Torrey Pines Scenic Drive. There is a driveway here on to the dirt leading to the Gliderport building. Once you're on to the dirt curve to your right (east) and approach the range of the graded surface of the gliderport runway. Directions are available online at <a href="http://archery.ucsd.edu/directions.html">http://archery.ucsd.edu/directions.html</a>. The range is the fenced outline just next to the 'CA84' marker on the aerial photo.
